

STEPHENSON LOCOMOTIVE SOCIETY LIBRARY INFORMATION

What is in the SLS Library?

- The book collection comprises over 15,000 titles covering railways throughout the World. Especially strong for the United Kingdom but also comprehensive coverage of Europe and North America.
- The list collection comprises 8 4-drawer cabinets of lists covering world-wide locomotive manufacturers and railway companies.
- There is an Excel database covering the book and list collections which is over 3MB which is available from the Librarian. The SLS web-site contains a non-searchable listing which is periodically updated.
- The image collection comprises more than 150,000 monochrome images and colour slides. Work is in progress to scan them to digital files of publishable quality – enquire of the Librarian for particular interests.

How to access what is in the Library?

The Library is located on the premises of Ian Allan Publishing, 52-54 Hamm Moor Lane, Addlestone, Surry KT15 2SF. On arrival, sign in at Reception and you will be directed to the Library which is located at the rear of the Warehouse area.

The Library is open to members and visitors on the 2nd Monday and 4th Wednesday of the month from 1300 to 1730. Earlier access is possible by agreement with the Librarian but office hours preclude later access.

Items may be borrowed for a period of one month or longer by agreement with the Librarian. Postal loans are available and must be returned to the Librarian's home address 166 Redland Road, Bristol BS6 6YG with refund of the forward postage.

The Librarian can arrange to scan items for overseas members by arrangement. For those with Broadband, web transfer services allow transfer of up to 10GB

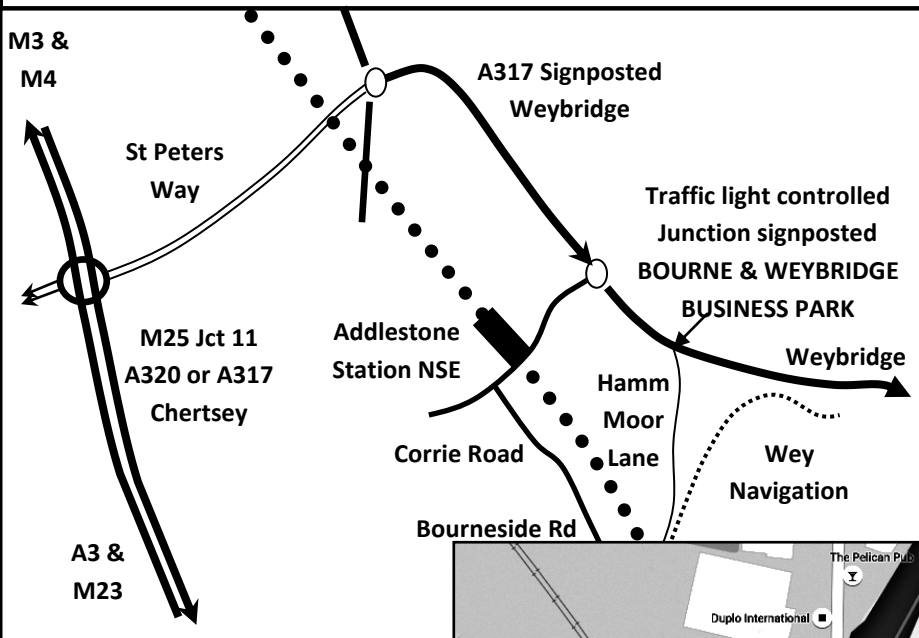

DIRECTIONS TO SLS LIBRARY AT IAN ALLAN, HERITAGE HOUSE, 52-54 HAMM MOOR LANE, ADDLESTONE SURREY KT15 2SF. On arrival sign in at Reception and you will be directed to Library at rear of Warehouse



By road from M25 Junction 11 onto A317 signposted Weybridge. From A317 after the Addlestone roundabout take the junction signposted WEYBRIDGE AND BOURNE INDUSTRIAL ESTATES. Hamm Moor Lane is straight ahead. The Ian Allan site is the last major building on the right after Locker 27 opposite the moorings on the Wey Navigation.



Walking from Addlestone Railway Station turn right on Station Road and take 2nd left Corrie Road and continue into Bourneside Road. At the entrance gate to the large buildings of Coxes Lock Mill turn left down the footpath & cross the railway by the footbridge. The Ian Allan building is on your left – walking time 15 minutes.

By bus Abellio bus services 461 (hourly from Staines to Kingston Stations and 514 (even hours from Walton Station) serve the Ham Moor Meadow Park Bus Stop between Weybridge and Addlestone with an hourly service and turn left into road signposted Weybridge and Bourne Industrial Estate. Follow Hamm Moor Lane as above – walking time 10 minutes from bus stop. Check online as times vary!
